### Project #281: Easter Egg Hunt!

- Purchase some plastic eggs which open. (Dollar Store)
- Purchase some Egg Shaped Chalk (Walmart)
- Place the chalk egg into the plastic egg.
- Tape one side closed with some scotch tape.
- Create a bowl full of eggs.
- Name the colours with the children.
- Count the eggs.
- Put the eggs into various categories such as red, blue, pink, yellow, green etc.
- Add the yellow and blue ones together (Adding)
- Take a few away and how many are left (Subtraction)
- Roll the eggs around (Do they roll evenly?)
- Think about putting some stickers onto the eggs or into the eggs.
- Candy could also put into the eggs but other items are nice too.

#### Activity: Egg Hunt!

Place your plastic eggs that are secured with tape around the house or in your yard and get ready to hunt for your eggs! See how many you can find. Try it again. Be sure to limit the egg amount to the number of children you have to be Fair! Trading colours of eggs with one another is a good sharing idea too!
