Project #282: Textured Eggs!

- Using a variety of paper egg shapes. Decorate with prints and paint and drawing.
- Another idea is to take the shells off of hard boiled eggs.
- Soak the shells in food colouring that is diluted with water; judge the portion of water to food colouring as you wish for brightness of the shells.
- Let these shells dry thoroughly.
- Glue the shells onto the egg shape that is made from construction paper or poster board. Nice textured effect of this egg!
- Another idea is to take your waxed paper and some tissue paper and place the tissue paper shapes in between two sheets of wax paper.
- Lay this onto some newspaper, place a light cloth on top of this and using a fairly hot iron, melt the pieces together by ironing over the top of the cloth. (children should not be doing this unless older children)
- Trim the edges with some scissors or even use the zig zag type of scissors for a fancier look!

Activity:

Read some Easter Books about eggs and easter bunny. Go to the store and look for various Easter Decorations whether buying or not. Field trip to "View" the items! Maybe there is an Easter Bunny in the Mall!
