Project #277: 3D Flowers in Pots

- Using some old playdough, place into a recycle Fruit or Pudding Cup.
- Cut out some flower shapes out of construction paper and tissue paper.
- Punch a hole into the centre of your flower shapes.
- Thread the flowers through a pipe cleaner and twist the top to secure the flower shape.
- Make many different types and colours of flowers by creating your own shapes.
- Think about adding some leaf shapes onto the pipe cleaner stem.
- These could also be made with straws that the flower may be threaded through.
- Place your flowers into the "Playdough Flower Pot"
- If you are making them with straws, they could be tied together in a bouquet with some ribbon. Taping them together would secure them so they don't slip. Then add the ribbon.
- When you are done with your creation, you may like to spray them with some perfume or sprinkle some scented powder on them.

Activity: Go for a Springtime walk and enjoy looking at the flowers. Smell the flowers. Note if there are bees or other insects on them. Talk about why the bees are on them; pollination.
