Project #283: Colours

- Using a blank piece of construction papers, let's do a colour collage
- Using various textures of paper, cut these into various shapes.
- These shapes can be random or they can have technical shapes such as triangle, square, rectangle, circle or other more detailed shape names depending on the age group of children.
- Glue your shapes onto your paper in any way you like.
- You may form landscape, houses, animals, trees, people, furniture, tables, chairs or just have a beautiful array of colours on your paper.
- If you use translucent paper such as tissue paper and layer it, the children will see how the colours blend and change. (red and yellow tissue paper blended to make orange.... Blue and Yellow.....)
- Try adding some lines and shapes with your felt markers. These may also change the colours on your masterpiece!
- Have fun and enjoy different ideas of what you think you could add to your creation!

Game: "I Spy"

I spy with my little eye, something that is RED (a colour)

The guessing person has to find the item you were thinking of that is the right colour.

For really young children, let them choose anything that matches the colour you are asking for.
