Project #286: Shapes!

- Cut out various shapes from various colours of paper.
- Use different types of paper.
- Design your shape picture in an abstract way and create some forms such as houses, cars, people etc.
- Try to use a variety of shapes.
- Name the shapes for the children to learn.
- Older children can learn the names of the more complex shapes.
- Add some colourful details around your shapes.
- Another idea is to use your Felt marker or crayon and continuously draw swirly lines which develop into pockets.
- Inside these "pocket shapes", colour them. This makes a nice free flowing abstract design and is quite soothing to create!

Activity: Use shapes on a magnetic board. Arrange your shapes in groups and name the group of shapes. Organise your shapes according to colours and name the colours. Count your shapes.
