

## **Ann's Creative Corner**

### **Project #287: Kites and Shapes!**

- Cut out a kite shape by folding the construction paper in half lengthwise.
- Cut a triangular piece off the top and the bottom of the unfolded area of the paper. Be sure to make them different sizes.
- Open the paper up and see the kite shape.
- If your shape is not correct, fold and redo the edges till you are happy with the shape.
- Use the spare pieces and cut into shapes for other art work.
- Draw a line from top to bottom of the kite at the points.
- Draw a line from side to side of the kite at the points.
- These two lines are the "Stick" of the kite.
- Place some tape at top and bottom of the kite to secure the area and then punch a hole with a hole puncher.
- Using more coloured shapes that you may create from various paper glue onto your kite.
- Draw on your kite.
- Use stickers on your kite.
- Attach a lightweight string or ribbon at the top and the bottom to fly your kite.

#### **Activity: Kite flying!**

Go outdoors and run with your kite! Twirl and swirl it with arm motions. Make a variety of colours of kites and go with family and friends. Talk about the colours and shapes on the kites.
