Project #288: The Sky!

- Create some cloud shapes out of plain white paper. Children can also do this. Clouds vary and are not perfect! Let the children do the cloud shapes as they like.
- Cut them out. Children that can use scissors can cut the cloud shapes.
- For children just learning to cut with scissors, give them small scraps of paper to snip. Small pieces of paper are easier to manage than large pieces. The snipped pieces of paper can also be used as a cloud or other object on the child's Creation.!
- Add some cotton balls to your clouds.
- For a different kind of a cloud, stretch some pieces of cotton.
- Glue your "clouds" onto a blue piece on construction paper.
- Add some details such as birds which can be as simple as an "m" shape in the sky.
- Try some stickers if you like but they are less creative than drawing.....
