

## **Ann's Creative Corner**

### **Project #289: Mother's Day Bouquet!**

- Cut some tissue paper of various colours into squares or rectangles (does not have to be perfect) Oor you could also use circles or ovals.
- Lay various colours on top of each other.
- Gather the layers and pinch them together to form your flower petals.
- Tape the point at where you pinched them and tape this with one thin layer of tape.
- Next, take a hole puncher and punch a hole at the bottom. If it is too thick, you may have to poke it with something a little sharper or cut a slit with scissors. This can be the "Adults" job while the children watch.
- Thread a pipe cleaner through the hole and twist closed. Children can do this and it is great for their fine motor control. This is the stem.
- With two pieces of the pipe cleaner at the bottom, the children can form the leaves.
- Next the children could use some felt marker on the leaves very gently to add more colour!
- When the flower is complete, spray it with your perfume!
- If you make a few, make a bouquet and wrap it in tissue paper for Mommy for Mother's Day!
