Project #295: Caterpillars and Butterflies!

- Cut out various colour of circles, from construction paper.
- On another piece of paper, attach with a glue stick to create your long colourful caterpillar! Use as many or as little as you like.
- Next, use some felt markers to make designs on the body of the caterpillar. Small dots are easy and effective especially for young toddler and children. Dots are always fun and simple!
- Add some face details such as sticker eyes or simply draw the eyes. The eyes could also be a large dot from a larger felt marker or a crayon.
- Using small cut out strips of paper, create legs and antenna and glue many many legs on the bottom and two strips for the antennas.
- The butterfly can have just the two antennas.
- For the butterfly, you may make your own butterfly shape by folding the paper in half and try to create the shape of the butterfly. This will make a nice Template to copy.
- Butterflies can also have a strip in the middle for the body.
- Decorate your butterfly using felt markers.

Activity: Butterfly and Caterpillar watch.....

Go for a walk and see if you can find some caterpillars in the trees, butterflies in the air or cocoons in the trees! Teach the children to view these creatures but not to touch them. Caterpillars can cause rashes. Plus we do not want to disturb nature or hurt them.
