Project #301: Fish Bowl/Aquarium!

- Cut the centre out of one paper plate.
- Cut out some fish and sea creatures from some scrapes of various types and colours of paper.
- Glue these shapes onto another full paper plate.
- Add more details with your felt markers or crayons.
- Add some texture such as sand or sparkles with some glue.
- When your picture is done, place the border of the other paper plate (Same Diameter) on top of your picture with your sea creatures to view.
- Staple, glue or tape all of the round edges to create the look of a fish tank or aquarium.
- The paper plates should create a raised "Bowl Like" centre.
- Punch a hole at the top if you like and attach a string to hang up!
- Tissue paper is a nice topping that looks like seaweed or sea flowers.
- Think about colouring the frame border with some felt markers or with a thin paint brush. Bingo dabbers may be good for this too. Or paint and colour it before attaching it to be sure it is dry and does not affect your picture.
