Ann's Creative Corner Project #302: Jelly Fish!

- Place two Basket type coffee filters together.
- Staple part of this to keep them straight.
- Crumple some tissue paper into a ball.
- Place inside the two coffee filters.
- Place a crumpled ball of tissue paper inside the partially stapled filters.
- Next complete stapling the edges to close the Circle.
- Using a hole puncher, punch holes around the circular edges.
- Cut some thin wrapping ribbon into fairly long strips as these will be inserted into the holes, folded and tied to secure them.
- These are the jellyfish tails/tentacles.
- For younger children, these can be premade and the children can colour them with Felt markers or even better "Bingo Dabbers"!
- Some Preschool Children may be able to help thread the ribbon into the hole and also stuff the tissue into the jellyfish.....

Aquarium:

Visit the Vancouver Aquarium if you can as they do have Jellyfish in tanks for all to view. Read books on jellyfish. See if you can find photos of jellyfish online as well.
