Project #303: Paper Plate Fish

- Cut out $\frac{1}{4}$ section of the paper plate as shown below.
- Attach this section to the other side of the paper plate to create the fin/tail for your fish.
- Decorate your fish with tin foil, bubble wrap, tissue paper etc by glueing it on.
- Draw an eye (or eyes if the children prefer more eyes as they often like to be sure the fish has at least 2 eyes)
- Colour the other parts of the fish as you like.
- These "Fish" could be painted as well with a thin paint brush.
- Bingo Dabbers are also good for this as the paper plate may be strong enough to absorb the bingo dabber paint.
- Attach a string to the top to hang your fish.
- Attach some food shapes to your fish mouth such as a worm.-
- Googly eyes or sticker eyes could be used.

Activity: Go to a pet store and view the various types of fish in the Aquariums. Notice the various colours, sizes and shapes of the fish. Some fish swim in Schools while others prefer to swim alone. Beta fish must be alone whereas Goldfish like to be together.
