- Fold a piece of construction paper in half to make a card.
- Place a NO. 1 DAD sign in the front of the card.
- Colour this and add some details as you like.
- Sticker could be used as well as the children colouring the sign in the front of the card.
- Open the card and continue with some writing in the card as shown here.
- My Dad! Lots of kids have Daddies, They think are very fine! But I'm the luckiest of all! Because I have you for MINE!
- Happy Father's Day from \_\_\_\_\_\_. Or Love From \_\_\_\_\_-
- Add some shapes like balls, cars, golf, hockey or whatever your dad may like.
- Cutting out some small car shapes are easy for the young children to glue into the centre of this care.
- You may also type out the saying that you like and create your own custom wording and then print it out for the children to glue into the centre of the Card!
