Project # 311: Bean Booklets!

- Create a Bean Booklet or place the progression pictures in order onto a piece of paper.
- Have a package of bean seeds to view the seeds as well as the package so you may see the photo of the beans.
- Do this project in conjunction with bean seed starting and planting project (#310)
- Colour the beans, soil and sun in the colours that are appropriate. Younger children and toddlers may have their own ideas of colours which is fine.
- For this project, it is better to use crayon or pencil crayons as the booklets and photo slides should be legible to see the growth pattern of the pictures. Felt markers can cover the picture too much so it may not be legible after.....
- If you choose the booklet style, be sure to let the pages dry before glueing onto the next page so the pages do not get stuck!
- Please look online for this project print sheet to make a copy. Or you could also take photos and make the sequence yourself and create your own unique Booklet or spreadsheet!

Activity:

Read books on planting and growing of vegetables and flowers.

Compare the various types of bean seeds you may find. Pole Beans.

Bush beans. Beans have different coloured shells too!
