

## **Ann's Creative Corner**

### **Project #314: Colour Wheels**

- Cut out a large Circle of any colour for base of the project.
- Cut 3 circles the same size of the Primary Colours: RED, YELLOW and BLUE.
- Cut these circle into 3 equal pie shaped pieces as shown below.
- Glue these three primary colours onto your base circle for the Primary colours of the wheel.
- Next cut 3 circles of the same size in the Secondary colours which are Green, Orange and Purple.
- Cut these circles into 6 pie shaped pieces.
- Glue 3 of these coloured pieces onto the circle in the order that red and yellow make orange, blue and red make purple and blue and yellow make green.
- You now have a colour wheel with six colours!
- Add sparkles if you like or the children can draw on them as well
- For children that can print, they could add the colours by printing the letters.
- Adults could also assist in writing the names of the colours.
- Make two wheels, one with just primary colours and the other with Primary and Secondary colours.

#### **Activity:**

Count the colours. Name the colours.

Try mixing paints together to experiment with colours changing!
