- Cut out a bee shaped body from yellow or brown paper.
- Cut out some wings from see through wax paper.
- Place your bee shaped body onto a paper and glue them down.
- Add some paper stripes for the bee's body by making them slightly curved from black paper.
- Add a little triangle on the end of the bee for its "Stinger".
- Glue the wings onto the body of the bee.
- Make a shape similar to below to create a bee hive.
- Draw some honeycomb type lines onto it or the children can do their own types of lines (be creative).
- Add some smaller bee shapes onto the beehive.
- If you children would like to do more, please enjoy this as they could also do flowers, trees, sky etc....
