Project #316: Turtles!

- Create Turtle Head shape, 4 Legs and a small triangle tail
- Cut these out or have older children cut them out if capable.
- Attach these to a paper plate in the order shown below.
- Next the children can colour the paper plate or draw lines in any way they think the turtle should look.
- You could have a picture of a real turtle or a general sample of the lines of the Turtles Shell.
- Try Bingo Dabbers on your turtle as this could make a nice design and the paper plate absorbs this quite well.
- Try using thin paint brushes.
- Stamps are an idea as well.
- Sometimes Turtle have sand on them so maybe add a little non toxic white glue to your turtle and sprinkle some sand onto it.
- Some green tissue strips could look like seaweed on the turtle...
