Ann's Creative Corner Project #317: Birds!

- Create a Bird Shape.
- Add some glue.
- Glue some feathers that you could purchase from a craft or dollar store.
- Add details to the face such as eyes and coloured beak. Some lines, dots or other designs the children may like to draw will make the bird unique and creative.
- If you have some fabric, this could stick with some White Liquid non-toxic glue.
- Glue your bird onto another piece of paper.
- Make a Mobile and hang your bird or birds. Make some smaller ones for a mobile and attach them to a stick, rod or hanger.
- Watch them fly in the wind or in front of a fan....

Activity: Bird Walk and Watch

Go for a walk and notice the various types of birds, colours, sizes, shapes and where they live in trees, on the water and see if you can find where they nest. Often you see nests in warmer secluded spaces within the building envelopes of houses and other structures. Talk about safety for the birds and do not touch the eggs or nests if you see them as the mother may abandon the nest if touched. Read a book on birds and nests.
