Project #320: Elephants!

- Create two smaller circles for the ears and one larger circle for the head. Trim the smaller ones into an ear shape as shown below.
- Create a curvy trunk shape for the elephant's nose.
- Add a chin shape as you see fit as well
- Glue all pieces together to create your own unique elephant head shape.
- Fill in some details of the face, eyes and some colours. Pink is nice for inside the ears.
- Children can decide how their unique elephant will look. Please do not over direct the children as this is a a very flexible and creative project if you let them do the creating.
- Some children may want to add a body to the head so have the head glued onto a piece of construction paper.
- Some children may also want to add other things to their creation such as trees, birds and other animals.

Activity:

Sing some elephant songs such as elephants marching here and there! Make up your own words and tunes if you like. Elephants can march high and low, up and down, in and out etc. You choose the actions and the words. Stomp like elephants. Make foot prints like elephants if you are on the beach and in the sand........
