Project #321: Dance Ribbons!

- Purchase some plastic ribbon (Canadian Tire or Home Depot)
- Try to find various colours.
- Cut the plastic ribbon to the length that you prefer but make sure it is long enough for double length.
- Using a pipe cleaner which you can buy in most craft stores or Dollar Stores, create a circle and twist it together. Children can usually create the circle and may need some assistance in securing the circle by twisting the pipe cleaners to secure the ends into the circular shape.
- Attach the plastic ribbons by looping it through the circle and tying it securely.
- You may also fold the long ribbon in half and loop it together in the middle.
- Add various colours of ribbons if you have the colours.

Activity: Using Music., create a Ribbon Dance.

Try dancing the Hokey Pokey with the ribbons.

Try just moving the ribbons up and down and side to side. Left and right, in and out..... This helps children understand the movement concepts of the action words.
