- Collect various sizes of Boxes.
- Construct them together by taping them in various sections.
- Create a handle as shown below and attach this with Masking Tape. This handle is made from the plastic strip from inside a packaging box.
- Children can then decorate the box by glueing shapes onto it.
- Try colouring or drawing on your boxes.
- Painting the boxes or putting sparkles on them would be fun too!
- Think about what you can use your box creation for.....

- Try some textured paper.
- Try some other things such as cotton, wool string.....
