Ann's Creative Corner Project #324: Ladybugs!

- Using two different size circles create your bug shape on some construction paper as shown below.
- Glue this shape onto another piece of paper.
- Make the larger circle again and cut it in half as this will be the wings of the ladybug.
- Glue the wings onto the body leaving the smaller circle free as it is the head of the bug.
- Add some eyes and mouth to the head part of the ladybug.
- Add some dots to the wings.
- Add 6 legs if you like by drawing the legs.
- Add some antennas by drawing them. The photo of the real ladybug does show they have feelers or antennae.
- Add more details to your bug as you like.
- Please be free to let the toddlers and Preschoolers to create their own ideas. Sometimes they will even pull the pieces off and on.
- Add details to the page such as grass or trees, sky etc.
