Project #326: Rodents!

- Create a basic rodent shape from a piece of brown construction paper. (other colours are fine too)
- Glue this shape onto another paper of any colour you choose. You may want it to be an earth colour or a bright colour. Please let the children choose the colour as it is their project.
- Add some details with our felt markers or crayons such as the eyes, nose mouth and feet.
- Add some whiskers and a tail from some thin wrapping ribbon. Try various colours. The ribbon can be glued or taped n depending on what the child is capable of. Remember that the younger children will experiment by pulling the tail and whiskers off again. The process not the product!
- Add some other types of wool or string to the body of your rodent.
- Add details to the page such as simple grass, sky or just some lines. Let the children create this vision of how they see it!
- Add more than one rodent or different sizes of rodents.

<u>Activity:</u> Go for a walk and you may see a mouse, possum or a rat. Talk about safety as not to touch them as they can bite. You may notice the rodent traps as well. Read books on rodents. Visit a pet store to see the guinea pigs, rats, and mice.
