Project #327: Rockets!

- Create a rocket shape out of a blue piece of paper or other colours if you choose it.
- Cut some yellow and orange squares, circles and rectangles.
- Cut some thin yellow strips of paper as well as these will be the fire on the rockets tail.
- Assemble pieces together by glueing them onto a black piece of construction paper. Children can choose how they like to assemble their own rocket. We can guide them with some ideas but it is their project!
- Add some details with felt markers.
- Add some sparkles to the rocket and the sky. Try yellow and silver but you could use other colours as well. Sparkle glue works nicely for this as it is premixed. Or you can shake sparkles onto your glue that you put onto the paper. Glue Sticks are fine for this and sparkles stick well.
- Draw or glue on some planet shapes!
