Project #328: Clouds and the Sky!

- Cut various cloud shapes out of white, grey and light blue paper.
- Make them various shapes as all clouds are different. You could make light fluffy clouds, slim clouds, dark rainy clouds etc.
- Make some rain drops out of your scrap paper.
- Make a circle for the sunshine as well and the sun's rays out of the scraps.
- Think about adding some lightning bolts by creating them with your scrap yellow paper!
- The children can arrange these on a dark or light blue piece of construction paper to create their own "Sky Scene".
- Take some cotton balls and have the children pull small pieces of the cotton to place on their clouds or to form a natural cloud on the paper.
- Some children may think about a rainbow as the rain and sun make a rainbow!
- Use felt markers to add a rainbow or other details to your paper.

Story: "It Looked like Spilt Milk" (about the shapes of clouds)

With this story it is easy to make felt pieces out of the shapes in the book. Children can be holding a shape and when it is their turn and they see it in the book, they place it on the felt board. Go outside and lay on the grass and watch the clouds drift by!
