Project #331: Happy Tooth and Apples!

- Create a simple tooth shape/s
- Glue this shape onto a piece of construction paper.
- Children can add details such as a happy face.
- Older children may add some teeth to the mouth.
- If the children are younger such as toddlers, they may want to just colour the tooth.
- Add pieces of scrap paper if you like.... These could be cavities...
- Add an apple to your creation.
- Apples are good for helping to clean your teeth after eating.
- Colour the apple.
- Add tissue paper or other paper to your apple to give it texture and more colour.
- Apples can be green, red or yellow so be creative!

Activity: Apple Sauce

Make apple sauce by peeling your apples, cut and put into a sauce pan with minimal water. Sautee gently while stirring occasionally. When apples are nicely soft, add a little cinnamon. Sugar is not needed at all! Eat when slightly warm or cold. Store in the fridge. Children can help with this by cutting small pieces of apple with a butter knife (no sharp knives are needed for cutting softer apples) Macintosh apples are great for this project! Tangy but sweet especially when adding cinnamon!
