Project #338: Masks!

- Cut out a mask shape from some foam craft paper.
- This could also be done with materials such as cardboard, coffee filters, hot dog type base paper etc.
- Punch holes into each end. Securing the space with tape is good before punching the holes. The mask will not rip as easily.
- Decorate your mask with felt markers, crayons, stickers, feathers and any other kind of non-toxic decorations you may think of.
- Masks could even have natural items that you may find outdoors like flowers, slim twigs etc.
- Try using some bingo dabbers on them, let dry and continue decorating.
- Make the masks in various shapes.
- If you choose to make an animal shape, it would be great to use some string, wool or cotton on your mask.
- Add some string to the ends to tie on. Pipe cleaners also work well for this.
