Ann's Creative Corner Project #340: Fall Leaves

- Cut out various leaf shapes from construction paper of various Fall Colours such as red, yellow, green and brown.
- Use the scrap paper to cut into smaller pieces.
- Using a glue stick, cover your leaf with glue.
- Add the scraps of coloured paper to create the changing of colours in your leaf.
- Add some tissue paper either flat or crumpled.
- If you lay the tissue paper flat and over top of each other, the colours will change. Note this to the children so they learn about how two colours or three colours will change the colours!
- You may also like to use real leaf pieces to glue onto your leaf.
- Try making leaves from coffee filters as well and colour them with a felt marker.
- Make a Stuffed leaf by taking two large fairly basic leaves out of thinner paper. Staple them partly together and stuff them with your scrap paper.
- Paint them!

Activity and Song:

Take a Fall walk and collect leaves that have fallen to the ground. Song/chant: (Tune: "Are you sleeping" make actions with hands) See them Falling, See them Falling,

To the Ground, To the Ground,

Red and yellow, green and brown, Red and Yellow, green and Brown, Green and Brown, Green and Brown.
