Project #341: Fall Trees

- Create a tree using a pre-drawn photo copy of a template.
- Create a tree by cutting various pieces of construction paper to form the tree trunk and branches.
- Form your tree by glueing the Trunk onto a piece of Blue or Green Construction paper.
- Add the various branches in the way you like. Children can decide how many branches and how to create the tree. You can guide them a little by showing them a picture of a tree or looking at real trees to see how they are formed.
- Cut some small leaves out of your scrap paper of various colours.
- Glue some leaves onto the paper and some below or above the tree.
- These will be falling leaves or leaves blowing in the wind.
- Use a felt marker or crayons on your tree.
- Add some tissue paper leaves or scrunch it up for the 3D look of leaves.
- If you glue small leaves on, older children may be able to put the details on the leaves such as the centre line and the "veins".
- Try making a small tree and add a popsicle stick for a trunk!
