Project #342: Fall Squirrels!

- Create a Large Squirrel shape out of construction paper using brown or black. Other colours are okay too as children are creative!
- Cut a smaller shape if you like too.
- Place the shape/s onto a piece of construction paper.
- Add details to the squirrel by drawing eyes, nose, mouth.
- Add some lines that may resemble the fur of the squirrel.
- Using some liquid white glue, you may like to add Felt. pieces of fabric. Wool or string to add a 3D dimension to your squirrel.
- Draw other details onto your creation such as trees or other scenery around the squirrel.
- Squirrels like nuts so maybe draw some nut shapes or the squirrel could be eating a nut.....
- Add the sky, rain, sun or maybe even some birds and leaves.

Chant with Actions:

Hop oh squirrel, Listen, Listen (hop and hand to ears)

Hop oh squirrel, Listen Now. (Repeat actions)

Think about other things for the Squirrel and be creative with the chant.
