Ann's Creative Corner Project #343: Turkeys!

- Create a Turkey shape from construction paper.
- Add a sticker eye or googly eye (older children for googly eye as it can be a choking hazard)
- Using a glue stick or liquid non toxic white glue, glue on some feathers to the tail part. Children may want to do a few feathers, many feathers or none. Please let them arrange the feathers as they see it. Sometimes they may put the feather on any part of the Turkey shape.
- Add a peak and the plume at the bottom of the face by cutting some orange paper to fit.
- Add some feet by cutting out some orange feet if you like.
- Children may like to colour the turkey with felt markers or crayons.
- Other ideas would be to make a Turkey shape by tracing your hand as the tail part.....
- You may also like to use prints of turkeys to glue and colour.
