Project #347: Harvest!

- Cut out some shapes of fruits and vegetables.
- Cut out some magazine photos of the fruits and vegetables as well.
- On a plain piece of paper, make a collage by glueing them on with a glue stick. IT IS EASIER For Children to spread the glue onto the paper first and then stick the pictures to the glue on the paper.
- If you have some old seeds that will not germinate, try adding some details to your collage by glueing a few onto the paper as well.
- Children could also draw on the picture.
- Try making a basket shape and putting fruit pictures into the basket with the glue.
- If you are making a basket shape, children could also add some details such as the lines of the basket or other drawings they may like to do. Chalk is nice to use on construction paper!

Activity:

Make a real Fruit and Vegetable Basket at home. Shop together for the items first. If you don't have a basket, use a plastic bowl. Go to a farm to view the Harvest Items. Country markets are great for this project!
