

## **Ann's Creative Corner**

### **Project #349: Pumpkins!**

- Cut out various pumpkin shapes of various sizes and shapes, big and small. Remember pumpkins are not perfect shapes!
- Draw curved lines on them to accent the 3D shape if you like.
- Add scraps of other construction paper in various shapes for eyes, nose and a mouth for a Jack-O- Lantern.
- Glue pieces on. Add other shapes or details such as leaves and soil pieces to accent your pumpkin or Jack o Lantern.
- Add a stem from paper to the top.
- Children can also draw on the pumpkin.
- Glue your pumpkin/s on a piece of paper.
- Add details to this art around the pumpkin. Maybe it would be a pumpkin patch?
- Scrapes of tissue paper would make a ice 3D look as well and it may look more natural.
- Try some stickers although stickers can add details, they are less creative. Children should learn to use their own hands for drawing and making details even if it is just dots or lines.....

#### **Activities:**

Go to a farm to visit a pumpkin patch. Notice pumpkins as you may be driving in the country areas. View pumpkins in the stores.
