Project #350: Ghosts!

- Create a simple ghost shape from some white paper, construction paper is quite strong for this. Make them various sizes and shapes as they are very flexible.
- Cut out some pumpkin and leaf shapes.
- Cut out some eyes and mouth shapes.
- Start by glueing the shapes on as you like. Children are very creative so do not over direct them. The shapes can be placed anywhere they see fit!
- Use some felt markers to draw on the ghost. The children may like to draw on the eyes and the mouth or they may like to draw other colours and shapes onto their "Ghost"
- Add some sparkles!
- Add some tissue paper!
- Think of other items you may like to glue on..... Cotton.....
- Try painting with a QTip.
- Glue your ghost/s onto another piece of paper. Black paper would be a nice background paper...
