Project #352: 3D Ghosts!

- Materials: Coffee Filters, Paper Towels, Tape, String or Ribbon, Felt Markers.
- Lay the coffee filter flat.
- Scrunch up a piece of a paper towel and place in the centre of the Coffee Filter.
- Pinch the Filter around the paper towel to form the head of the ghost.
- Twist the base a little to tighten the space for the "neck" of the ghost.
- Apply tape around the neck area to pinch the neck area and form the neck and body of your ghost!
- Using a felt marker, dot a face onto your ghost by simply dotting the eyes and mouth on. You could also use a regular pen and try to draw the details on. The filters are quite strong so this is possible. The ink pens will not fade or run the ink as they are permanent.
- Add some sparkles by painting the liquid sparkles on.....
- Stickers are another idea to put on your ghost.
- Tie string on neck to hang if you wish.
