Project #348: Acorns!

- Create an acorn top and bottom shape.
- Children can glue these onto a piece of construction paper.
- Add details to your acorn/s with felt markers or crayons.
- Think about what animals may like to eat and store acorns such as squirrels.
- Maybe you could add some squirrel stickers.
- If children can draw their own squirrel, please encourage this to be creative!
- Add some natural items to the paper such as pressed dried real leaves!
- Some natural coloured string or wool could also be a part of this creation. Tissue paper as well to give it texture.
- Make a double acorn by stapling two together.

Activity:

Go for a walk and you will see many acorns and chestnuts falling from the trees. Make a collection! Play games with them. Count them. Match them. Trade them. Place them on a "Science Table" There may be stacking games such as the one shown below!
