Project #361: Community Shopping Carts!

- Create a Shopping cart shape from construction paper. Use various colours so children may choose.
- Cut out and have children cut out items for their shopping cart from magazines, catalogues or flyers.
- Children can "Load" their shopping cart with the items they choose.
- Another idea would be to use photocopies of various items that the children may choose from.
- Children may also like to draw their own items.
- Stickers could also be used.
- Colour your shopping cart.
- Older children may be able to draw a shopping cart and fill it with their own drawings or cut out pictures.

Activities:

Go to a store or a few stores and see the various types of shopping carts. Some stores may have a smaller version of the shopping cart for the children to use.

Play in your housekeeping area with a toy shopping cart if you have one. Set up a "Grocery Store" in a Dramatic Play area in your home or School.
