Project #364: Candy Canes

- Let's make a cane cane shape out of various types of paper.
- Construction paper candy canes to glue onto another piece of construction paper is a good idea.
- Poster board candy can shapes are great for durability.
- Add details of the stripes to your candy canes by using a glue stick and strips of paper. They do not have to fit exactly as they can be trimmed to the candy cane shape after it is dry.
- Add some sparkle to this using liquid sparkle glue or a glue stick with sprinkles of Sparkles. Please be sure to have a container for sprinkle glitter that has small holes for pouring. Also the lids must be secure. Good idea to tape the lids closed and remind children that the <u>Tape Stays On</u>
- A box or plastic recycle type container is great to put under the candy cane so you may reuse the fallen sparkles!
- Add a bow if you like!
