Project #366: 3D Christmas Trees!

- Glue 3 popsicle sticks together in a triangle shape. Liquid white School Glue can work and let it dry.
- If you prefer, you could use a glue gun to attach them into a triangle shape (Adults could prepare these ahead of time for you younger children.
- Next, you may like to wrap the triangle in wool, pipe cleaners or ribbons would be nice too. Ribbons may be easier for some children.
- These also could have some evergreen type wrapping details as well.
- When you are done preparing your tree, add some decorations with the Liquid White Glue. Squirt the white liquid glue onto the tree in droplets and add some shiny decorations, pom, poms or beads. Be careful for the toddlers and Preschools as some materials such as beads can be a choking Hazard.
- Sprinkle some glitter onto your tree!
- Add a string or ribbons to the top for an ornament!
