Project #367: Bells!

- Make a Bell Shape out of construction paper.
- Place some tape at the top.
- Punch two holes with a hole puncher on the tape part. The tape will help the paper not rip.
- Add a ribbon to the top by sliding it through the holes. Tie a bow if you like. Use various colours and if the ribbon is narrow, use more than one colour.
- Children can then decorate the bell with various drawings, sparkles, stickers, paper shapes, shiny paper and other glueable items. Pieces of fabric or felt may also be used for this if you use non toxic white glue.
- Try making various sizes of bells.
- Make a mobile with them
- Add a small bell to the bottom of them. Place some tape on the paper and then punch a hole before threading the bell through with some nice strong or ribbon.
