Ann's Creative Corner Project #370: Christmas/Holiday Wreath!

- Create a Wreath Shape by cutting out a circle with some fluted edges.
- Or use a paper plate and cut out the centre so it becomes a circular ring.
- You may also use the entire paper plate especially for the younger preschoolers and toddlers.
- First put some tape onto the top part.
- Punch two holes through this and attach your ribbon or string and create a bow. Adults can help the younger children with this but it is good for fine motor control to have the children try to put the string or ribbon through the holes. Adults can tie it and make a bow.
- Next children can decorate this with many items such as Felt markers, shiny paper, glitter, stickers and even add some real pine tree or evergreen pieces with non toxic white glue.
- If you like, try painting it with a simple QTip dipped lightly into paint.
- Cotton Balls would also look nice on this. Sprinkle the cotton with glitter after it is glued onto the Wreath.

Activity:

Walk in your neighbourhood or complex and see how many different wreaths you may see on the doors.
