Project #369: Christmas and Holiday Cards!

(By Kids Care Preschool and SVFP)

- Fold a piece of construction paper in half.
- Cut out various Shapes such as Stockings, Christmas Trees, Stars and other shapes you may like
- Glue your favourite shape onto the front of your card.
- Add a felt piece and use non toxic white glue if you like.
- On the inside decorate some more with your other shapes that you choose.
- Add a verse to the inside of the Card and/or To, From, Love _____
- On the front of the card add Merry Christmas or Happy Holidays, whichever you prefer.
- Add some stickers, glitter or other shiny papers that would look nice for your card.
- If you would like to use some felt pieces and shapes, use non toxic white glue.
- If the children can, please ask them to try to write their own name. If they are young, write it for them while they watch. Please say the letters as you print them so they get the concept of how to print their name. Please remember that names are spelt with first letter only as an uppercase capital letter. The rest are the lowercase letters.

Activity:

Address your card and have the children put a stamp on the top right hand corner. Add some special stickers to it. Walk to the local Mail Box and have children place the card into the mailbox!
