Project #365: Handprint Reindeer!

(Project by Kids Care Preschool)

- Using non toxic liquid paint make two attached handprints as shown below.
- You may like to use a paint brush and “Paint the child’s palm of the hand” Press onto a piece of construction paper and let it dry.
- If a child does not like this as some children do not like their hand painted, you may trace the child’s hands instead.
- The child may then like to paint it with a brush or colour it with felt markers.
- After the handprints and painting are done and dry it is time to add some details.
- Ideas are: A paper collar, pom poms, glitter, tissue paper, google eyes (older children) Sticker eyes (younger children)
- Use some cotton or pom pom for the nose.
- If you are making Rudolf, be sure to have some red pom, poms available.
- Other ideas could be using some wool for fur or some felt or other fabric pieces on your reindeer!

Song: Rudolph The Red Nosed Reindeer”

The song is quite long so the adults can sing all of it while the children sing as much as they can. Sometimes, you may pause and encourage the children to repeat the more simple words of the song!
