### **Project #372: Colourful Prints with Shapes**

(Project by South Van Family Place)

- Place non toxic liquid paint into a small flat lid or on a paper towel in a flat container.
- Use some shapes such as cookie cutters, playdough tools, sponges etc to dip into paint.
- Press paint shapes onto various colours of paper; construction paper is nice for this as it absorbs the paint nicely
- Notice how the colours change as they blend (yellow and blue make green, red and yellow make orange, blue and red make purple etc.
- What happens if you mix all the colours together..... Brown maybe.....
- When you are done with the printing, you could add some sparkles to this if the paint is still wet. Sprinkle the Sparkles onto the shapes too!
- Add other textures to this such as coloured paper, shiny paper, cotton pieces etc.

#### **Activity:**

**Science:** Mix colours in a water container such as a clear plastic bottle. Slowly add a few drops of food colouring and watch the water change colour! Be very slow with the mixing as too much food colouring will just turn brown.....
