Project #374: Colourful Handprints and Shapes!

(project by South Van Family Place)

- Trace your child's hand or use a basic template of a hand print.
- Add details such as fingernails and other features of your hand with felt markers.
- Decorate with sparkles if you like.
- Make these into gloves by making two and taping them together.
- Make your hand shapes out of felt materials and an adult or older child may glue them together with liquid white glue.
- Let dry and try them on.
- Add some sequins or beads using liquid white glue.
- If children can use a shoelace, try punching holes into the shape and weave two together.
- The paper handprints can be used for a goodbye card for someone leaving or they could be used as a welcoming card as well as a Hello Card! Add some stickers or other details to your cards.
