Anns Creative Corner Project #373: Snow Flakes!

- Using a coffee filter; create your snowflake.
- Fold in half.
- Fold in quarters.
- Snip the point that you created
- Snip on the folds.
- Snip on the edges.
- Be careful not to cut through the entire coffee filter or make the holes too. Big.
- Snipping simple triangles work the best for this project.
- When snipping is done, open the coffee filter slowly and see your snowflake!
- Other ideas are: use some sparkle glue after you open it up, add colours with felt markers, or maybe very thin water colours of paint, add some cotton!
- Hang your snow flakes as a mobile on a stick.
- Place them on a window or mirror.

Activities:

Play in the snow, go ice skating, try skiing, snowboarding or view the mountains with snow. Look at snow pictures; calendars may have very nice prints. Melt some ice. Make a snow cone by grinding up ice and adding some flavour crystals to it.
