Ann's Creative Corner Project #376: Dragon Puppets!

- Photo copy a dragon shape on half of your paper
- Fold over and glue in place.
- Cut around the dragon shape.
- This can be done simply without following the lines exactly; great for children who are learning to cut. Or Adults can do this for the younger Preschoolers and Toddlers. If the children would like to practise cutting with small scissors, they could practise snipping the small scraps of paper. Small pieces are easier for the young children to cut as large pieces of paper are awkward.
- Next add some shiny streamers to your dragon. In this one, I used red tinsel and attached it with scotch tape.
- Use felt markers to colour your dragon.
- Add some stickers if you like.
- Use Sparkle glue or a glue stick and sprinkle some sparkles!
- When completed, attached a straw or popsicle stick to the back of the dragon puppet.
