### Project #382: Rainy Day Umbrellas!

- Cut out some umbrella shapes from various colours of construction paper. Try making different sizes too!
- Children can add detail lines to them to form the curve of the umbrella (older children may like to try this)
- Younger children can colour the umbrella anyway they like! It is their creation!
- Add some raindrops to this by glueing on the raindrop shapes that you may cut out using scraps of paper.
- Add some sparkles with sparkle glue if you like.
- Try small bingo dabbers to make dots.
- Stamps and stamp pads could also be used.
- Try a few stickers but be sure to encourage their own creativity as well.
- Make some larger umbrellas on plain large paper and place on an easel for painting.
- Try laying the shape in a small lid from a box and roll a small ball with paint on it around to colour the umbrella.
- Paint it with a QTip.....
