- Create a rabbit shape.
- Colour it.
- Add cotton balls, wool or string.
- Create the eye by drawing it. You may like to use sticker eyes or googly eyes (older children for googly eyes as they can be a choking hazard)
- Try painting the bunny with a small QTip.
- Make a collage of various rabbits out of magazine pictures, calendar photos etc.
- Make a field of bunnies by using small stickers and also drawing in the grass and scenery.
- Think of some rabbit foods and try drawing things for your Rabbit like carrots, lettuce and other vegetables a rabbit may eat.

<u>Chant:</u> <u>Robbie The Rabbit (create the actions while crouching down)</u>
