Project #381: Happy Clouds!

- Cut out various sizes and shapes of clouds. These could also be various colours but most are usually white or grey.
- Cut out various colours of strips of paper.
- Cut out some rain shapes such as in a drop form.
- Have some sticker eyes, googly eyes (older children) or plain circle stickers for eyes.
- Children can create their own "Happy Cloud"! Or it could be a "Sad Cloud" or any expression the child may be feeling!
- Using a glue stick, attach the various colours of "rays" to the cloud. This could be at the bottom but the children may also like to put these at the top (could be hair to the child) Be flexible!
- Add the "Raindrops" to the cloud.
- Draw a mouth shape on it which could be happy, sad, surprised, etc.
- Add the eyes with your stickers, google eyes or draw them (drawing is more creative)
- When the cloud is done, add some sparkles if you like.
- Let dry and attach a string if you like to hang it up, make a mobile with lots of clouds on a stick..... If the clouds are in a mobile, you may like to make clouds from thicker paper or put backing of construction paper behind the cloud/s.

Song/Chant: "Rain is Falling Down" (make up your actions!)

Rain is falling down, Splash! Rain is falling down, Splash!

Pitter patter, pitter patter, Rain is falling down, Splash!

Sun is peeking out, Peek! Sun is Peeking Out Peek!

Peeking here, peeking there, Sun is peeking out Peek!
